GO Competition ARPA-E Official Registration Last modified: January 27, 2019

This section of the document describes the **steps needed for an entire team to officially register** with ARPA-E. Part of this official registration process will require access to the https://gocompetition.energy.gov website.

The first section is intended for Entrants (team members) and describes the necessary steps to send their official forms to their Team Leader.

The second section is intended for the Team Leader and describes the necessary steps to send his/her team's official forms to ARPA-E.

Entrant (Team Member) Instructions


1. Go to the ARPA-E Grid Optimization Competition website at https://gocompetition.energy.gov.




2. In the upper right corner, click on the Log In link.



3. Log into your account using your GO Competition website username and password.




4. You should see your My account page, similar to the image below.



5. Follow the instructions under ARPA-E Registration Forms. This section is located just under your full name and should look similar to the image below.



6. Under "Your Available Forms" section, click on the PDF link. This should prompt a save dialog box, similar to the image below. You can either open the PDF file or save the file to your local system. Select your choice and click the **OK** button. For this exercise, we saved the file to disk locally.




7. Go to the PDF file that you downloaded and open it with a PDF reader; go to the second page. Your file should look similar to the image below.



8. Verify all the required information is correct in your PDF. If not, edit the PDF OR print the PDF and correct the information manually. For example, the image in Step 7 is missing an e-mail address; the author needs to update this required field.

 Print a copy of your completed Entrant Registration form. Manually sign and date your form (no digital signatures allowed at this time). Include your state and country where you signed your document. Your final document should look something like the image below.



- 10. Scan your signed PDF document.
- 11. Send your signed PDF document to your Team Leader.

Minor Entrant Instructions

If you are a minor entrant (a team member that is under the age of 18 years), your form on your My account page will be the Minor Entrant Form for PDF download and should look similar to the image below:


- 9. Verify all the required information is correct in your PDF. If not, edit the PDF OR print the PDF and correct the information manually.
- 10. Print a copy of your completed Entrant Registration form. Manually sign and date your form (no digital signatures allowed at this time). Include your state and country where you signed your document. Your final document should look something like the image below.



- 11. Scan your signed PDF document.
- 12. Collect all the signed PDF Entrant Registration documents from all of your team members.
- 13. Create an ARPA-E Team Registration PDF packet that contains your Team Lead Entrant Document (from Step 10 above) and all of your team member's Entrant Registration document(s) adults and minors. Include any other supporting documents as per ARPA-E's instructions on the first page of the Team Lead's Entry Form that was downloaded from the GO Competition website.
- 14. Upload the Team Registration PDF packet. You will find this link under the "You must return your signed forms..." as noted by the red arrow in the image below.



15. You will be directed to the "Create Eligibility Documentation" page (https://gocompetition.energy.gov/node/add/eligibility-documentation). This page will allow you to send your registration PDF packet to ARPA-E for review. The required fields are marked with a red asterisk (*) and are noted in the next steps.



16. Skip the Eligibility Document Submission Title. This will be automatically created for you upon saving the web form.

17. Select the type of PDF packet that you are uploading for ARPA-E review. This is required information that will aid ARPA-E in understanding your submission packet.


19. Click the **Upload** button to upload your documentation to the GO Competition website. If successful, you should see something similar to the image below.

20. Enter any notes that clarify your documentation. This is optional information.

21. Click the **Save** button at the bottom of the page. This sends the PDF packet to ARPA-E for review.



22. At any time, the Team Leader can view the status of their submitted ARPA-E documents. Go to your My account page and under "View Form Status" you can click on the view link.



23. You will be directed to the "Submitted ARPA-E Competition Eligibility Documents" page (https://gocompetition.energy.gov/submitted competition forms). The status column shows the current state of your document; allowed states are "accepted", "pending", and "declined".



24. Once ARPA-E reviews your PDF packet, ARPA-E will respond directly to you via e-mail of their decision for your official registration/participation in the competition. If the

documentation has been approved/accepted by ARPA-E, GO Competition Administrator will be notified to enable your team to participate in the Sandbox submission.

25. Once the GO Competition Administrator has enabled your team for a Sandbox submission, you and all your team members will receive an e-mail, similar to the image below:

Congratulations! Your team. "Smith Optimization" has been approved by ARPA-E for the GO Competition.

If you have not already done so, copy the SSH key from your Team page, https://gocompetition.energy.gov/leams/smith-optimization, to your team's GitHub account. Instructions for this step can be found at: https://gocompetition.energy.gov/github-and-go-competition.

With the SSH key in place, you and your team members may now submit to the Competition Sandbox, which will validate the functioning of your solver with the Competition protocols on small problems with fast turn-around. Once you have a successful Sandbox submission, you will be granted access to the full Challenge 1 submission process. We suggest you start with the Sandbox dataset "Challenge 1: IEEE 14 Bus (1 scenario)" from the Dataset pull-down menu on the Sandbox submission page. The Sandbox uses only a Division 1 style invocation. Solution files will be evaluated as for Challenge 1 except the objective is simply set to a large value in the absence of the solution files.
